There has been a query made about FWO envelopes and church finances during the closure of our church services.

At this time my priorities are keeping our members safe and restricting the spread of this awful virus. Please pass on the information below to any member with whom you are in contact.

I am very happy for members to continue to fill their FWO envelopes each week and then to bring them to church when our services resume.

34 members give by bank monthly standing order and some periodically by cheque. I assume these will continue as usual.

As for the church finances, I am not concerned, as happily, this year we do not have a cash flow problem. I monitor our bank transactions daily online and have no concerns at the present time. I will send elders out details of income and expenditure at end of each month.

If you or someone you know would like to switch at this time from FWO envelopes to a bank monthly standing order I can post you out a form. Phone me on 713059. You simply fill in your bank details and post it to your bank.

As yet there has been no advice from 121 regarding Finance. If there is any change to be made or if I hear of a better way of dealing with this, I will let you know.

Our accounts have been sent to Ayr Presbytery and 121 well before the deadline of 5th April 2020. The only thing not done is a report to the congregation and this will be done some time after our church services resume.

I am confident that our faithful members will continue to support us generously.
